Sunday, July 24, 2016 - Johannesburg

Welcome to the 4th Annual GIVE Movement Journey to Africa. This is a transformational experience that Suzanne Evans has put together in partnership with Hills of Africa Travel to create movements that make a difference. This trip combines the Hell Yeah! We Care Habitat for Humanity movement with the Global Impact Project. You will learn more about yourself than you ever knew, you will be helping others to make a difference and your life will be forever changed. We are thrilled to have you join us on this journey!



Welcome to South Africa. On arrival in Johannesburg International Airport, you will need to clear South African immigrations, collect your luggage and proceed through customs. Please go all the way through to the Arrivals Hall (don't go through to transfers), where you will be met by your Hills of Africa guide (look for your name on a sign).



IMPORTANT INFORMATION - US passports do not require visas to enter South Africa BUT must have at least two empty pages in their passports for each country visited. Passports must be valid for at least 6 months from the date of departure from the last country visited.

In the arrivals hall, you will be met by your **Hills Of Africa Travel** representative who will transfer you to **The Peech Hotel**.



The Peech Hotel

Situated centrally in Melrose, The Peech Hotel is a boutique hotel in Johannesburg, featuring contemporary design.



Offering a bistro-inspired restaurant, lushly landscaped gardens, access to adjacent Planet Fitness Gym (for a small additional charge), rotating art and photography exhibits, private meeting rooms, a swimming pool and a library, The Peech Hotel has become known as contemporary and Afrocentric.

Newly launched eco-suites boast a number of environmental initiatives, guaranteeing that your stay will have as little impact on the environment as possible. These include solar water heating, grey water recycling, a



worm farm and the use of ecological detergents and cleaning agents.

Monday, July 25, 2016 - Johannesburg

This morning we will be collected from the hotel lobby and taken on a **private-guided tour of Soweto and The Apartheid Museum.**

The Apartheid Museum depicts the hostile and difficult conditions of South Africa's past and tells the story of "The Struggle" and the triumph of the human spirit. The museum is a superb example of design, space and landscape organized by a multi-disciplinary team of curators, film-makers, historians and designers.



Lunch today will be at Wandie's Place in the middle of the "township". This is a hot spot for enjoying local cuisine typical of Soweto.



Afterwards, **with your private guide you will embark on your tour of Soweto** (45-minute drive), one of the most well-known townships in South Africa and home to over 4 million people. Today, Soweto is a community of extremes. On the one hand there is abject poverty and on the other hand there is extraordinary wealth. You will learn about the post apartheid struggles that local South Africans face, by seeing where and how they live in townships.



We will pass by the **Hector Peterson Memorial Museum**, a truly moving place that brings you back to the day of a peaceful, student demonstration that turned violent by the authorities and **Vilakazi Street**, the only street in the world to have housed 2 Nobel Prize winners. During your tour, you will visit **The Mandela Museum**, Nelson Mandela's childhood home; **Freedom Square/Walter Sisulu Square**, where the ANC's Freedom Charter was proclaimed to thousands in 1956; and **The Regina Mundi Church**, where the bullet marked walls are witness to past security and police brutality.



Dinner at The Peech Hotel. After a long day of exploring Johannesburg and Soweto, we will return to The Peech Hotel for dinner under the stars.

Tuesday, July 26, 2016 - Lusaka

Today, we will meet in the Peech Lobby to begin the next phase of our GIVE Movement Journey. We will be transferred to the Johannesburg Airport.

We will check in for our international flights to Lusaka, Zambia. Before proceeding to your gate, you will need to clear customs & immigration exit controls. (This flight needs to be booked and is not included in the itinerary cost.)



We recommend booking on SAA flight SA 62, from Johannesburg to Lusaka:

10:25am Depart Johannesburg (JNB), SA 62

12:30pm Arrive Lusaka (LUN), SA 62

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: US Citizens DO require holiday visas to enter Zambia & Zimbabwe, which you can obtain on arrival. Please make sure you have at least two blank pages in a valid passport per country you are visiting. Passports must be valid for 6 months after departure from the last country visited.



Kaza Visa (univisa for Zambia & Zimbabwe): USD50 per person, valid for 30 days, with day trips into Botswana allowable.

Welcome to Lusaka! After clearing customs & immigration and collecting our luggage, we will be met by our driver in the Arrivals Hall.



We will then be taken to our hotel to check in, get settled, talk about the days ahead and get to know one another little better.

Radisson Blu Lusaka

The Radisson Blu Lusaka Hotel is located in a quiet area close to the city center, featuring a harmonious combination of classic elegance and modern amenities.

Room: 1 x double for 2 nights on sharing bed & breakfast basis (single supplements will apply)



We will enjoy dinner tonight sharing a meal together at The Radisson Blu Hotel.

Wednesday, July 27, 2016 - Lusaka

Today, we are going to be building a fully-funded Habitat for Humanity home for a Zambian family in a region of Lusaka. How cool is that? This program sets to link local and international volunteers with communities in Zambia for a life changing experience of cultural exchange, skills transfer, interaction and exhilarating time of your life. You will have the opportunity to interact with the families, neighbors, community leaders and Habitat liasions and you build side by side.



Over 1,680 houses have been constructed since the Habitat program began in Zambia. The average size of a HFHZ house is 35m squared (approximately 12 ft squared). These houses cost US\$6,000. In keeping with the ethos of using regionally appropriate technology, most rural houses are constructed of burnt bricks and covered with corrugated iron sheets. The houses are simple with well defined sleeping, cooking and living areas. The design may vary slightly from location to location, but generally the quality of a Habitat house far exceeds the typical low income house design.



Our trip is a testimony of how hope can be turned into homes.

We will take a break for lunch at about 12:00pm at a nearby restaurant. After a much needed lunch break,





we will return to the Habitat build at 2:00pm to work until about 4:30pm, when we will return to the hotel.

Dinner tonight will be served at The Radisson Blu Hotel.

Thursday, July 28, 2016 - Victoria Falls

Today, we will be collected from The Radisson Blu Hotel and transferred to **Lusaka Airport** where we will be helped to connect with our flight to **Livingstone and Victoria Falls**. (This flight needs to be booked with your international flights and is not included in your itinerary cost.)



Flight to book on Proflight:

10:55am Depart Lusaka (LUN), Proflight PO 704

12:05pm Arrive Livingstone (LVI), Proflight PO 704

On arrival at Livingstone Airport, you will collect your luggage and proceed to the arrivals hall. Here we will be met by our guide and transferred to the **Victoria Falls Hotel**. We will stop to clear Zimbabwe customs & immigration as we cross the border.



If you DID NOT purchase the **Kaza Visa** on arrival in Lusaka, you will need to purchase a **Zimbabwe tourist visa**: USD30 per person, single entry.

A sandwich lunch will be provided on the bus to Victoria Falls Hotel.



Victoria Falls Hotel

The Victoria Falls Hotel, popularly known as "the grand old lady of the Falls," is situated in the Victoria Falls National Park, a World Heritage Site, and is a member of the exclusive Leading Hotels of the World group. It is one of only three 150-accredited hotels in Zimbabwe.



The Edwardian-style five-star hotel, built in 1904, was recently redecorated and refurbished and now combines the charm of the old with the convenience of the new. Set in lush tropical gardens with lily ponds, palm trees and semi-tropical shrubs, it provides the tranquility and seclusion that many guests seek.



The famous Victoria Falls, referred to by locals as "the smoke that thunders," is just a ten-minute walk away using the hotel's private pathway.

Accommodation: 1 x deluxe room, central wing room on a sharing bed and breakfast rate for 3 nights (single supplements will apply)

Tour of the Falls - This afternoon, we will enjoy a **private guided tour of Victoria Falls, one of the 7 Natural Wonders of the World**. The sights, sounds, and aromas of the Falls are truly an awe-inspiring experience that provokes humbling feelings from within - here, indeed, is nature's supreme masterpiece. No photograph can begin to depict the reality, and nothing prepares you for your first sight.

After visiting the Victoria Falls we will be taken to the Womens Curio Market in the Traditional Craft Village.



This is our first introduction to the women we will be working with in Victoria Falls. Please come with open minds and open hearts - take some time to learn about the women here and the role they play in their family households. Enjoy wandering around the market, so you can learn about their livelihoods and also spend some time thinking about how we can help them to sell more arts and crafts. There will be local people in the village performing traditional skills such as carving, basket weaving and even cooking.



After our Tour of the Falls and Womens Curio Market visit, we will hop on our bus to Ilala Lodge where we will relax and enjoy a private cocktail reception and dinner.

After dinner, we will take the bus back to the Victoria Falls Hotel.

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch (served on the bus from Livingstone to Victoria Falls Hotel) and Dinner



Friday, July 29, 2016 - Victoria Falls

Be prepared to change your life and someone else's today. This morning we will be transferred to Chinotimba Township for our morning session with Suzanne Evans and the ladies we will be sharing with and learning from. Today's focus will be on listening. Our role is to evaluate what has worked for the women over the past year, what new issues have come about and how we can help facilitate them finding their own solutions. Remember: these women have as much to teach us (if not more!) than we have to teach them. Take note of their overwhelming gratitude for your support and aim to mirror the same.



Lunch will be provided for the ladies by our group before they return to their markets for the afternoon tourists. We will then be transferred back to the hotel.

Lunch today will be served at The Lookout overlooking the Victoria Falls Bridge and the gorge.



This afternoon is at your leisure. Maybe today is the day you take a jump and soar across the 300-meter Batoka Gorge, visit a local village, or take an elephant back safari. **If you are interested, reach out to your Hills of Africa Travel representative for more details on booking a supplemental afternoon activity. (Additional costs will apply.)**



This afternoon at about 4pm, we will meet in the Victoria Falls Hotel Lobby.

Sunset Cruise -This afternoon, we will be collected from the hotel lobby and driven to the Zambezi River above the Victoria Falls for a **3-course dinner and sunset cruise**. You will enjoy cruising the placid, upper Zambezi River. The Zambezi River cruise is a superb way to relax and enjoy the beauty of the river. Look for wildlife while you watch the African sun set. You may have the opportunity to see a variety of game; including hippo, crocodile and elephant in their home environment, as well as enjoy the many different bird species. There are great photo opportunities against often-spectacular African sunsets.

Saturday, July 30, 2016 - Victoria Falls

This morning at 8:45am we will meet in the lobby and be transferred to our morning session with Suzanne Evans and the women of Victoria Falls.

Today you will work more closely with the women of Zimbabwe on helping them to learn new strategies for their business and creative solutions to their problems with a clear and detailed action plan for their next week, month and year. Spend today thinking about your own businesses. Notice how these women are showing up everyday -- their unwillingness to give up, their unquenchable thirst for knowledge and their immense gratitude for every piece of business education -- and how it could transform your business if you applied even a fraction of their tenacity.



Lunch today will be served at The Club overlooking the beautiful Zambezi River.

This afternoon you are free to enjoy the Victoria Falls Hotel or take part in an afternoon activity.

This evening at 6:45pm, we will meet in the lobby of the Victoria Falls Hotel to be transferred to our special dinner with Aunt Flatter.

On the outskirts of **Victoria Falls Town is Chinotimba Township** which is where a lot of Zimbabweans working in the tourism industry in Victoria Falls live. It's a friendly township with proper houses and it is here that **Aunt Flatter and her likeminded neighbors have started their own businesses.** They welcome you into their homes to interact in an informal way and learn more about each others' countries, cultures and traditions. As Flatter's daughters prepare a tasty traditional Zimbabwean meal, you are able to ask questions - and be prepared to answer some as well! The food ranges from **beef and chicken stews to peanut laced pumpkin, mopane worms and the traditional sadza** which is a corn flour mash and the staple food in many countries in Southern Africa. Expect a unique and rare experience for the next few hours!

Sunday, July 31, 2016 - Hwange National Park

This morning you will have breakfast and then check out of The Victoria Falls Hotel. You will be met in the hotel lobby and transferred to The Hide in Hwange National Park. This is an approximately 2 hour ride in a small bus, on a private basis.

On arrival in Hwange National Park, you will be met by a guide from The Hide and driven through the park at game drive speed to camp - we hope you see lots of elephants!



The Hide

The Hide Safari Camp is fortunate to have the "best of both worlds". While located within the Hwange National Park, it is also surrounded by a private concession, which allows the ability to offer activities not



otherwise permitted in the National Park. Hwange is a haven for wildlife and one of Africa's premier game parks, bordering ancient elephant paths and a vast grassland corridor. Herds of elephant, buffalo and a myriad of others are drawn to the constant waters of the Hide's waterhole, and the spectacle of the great predators making a sudden appearance is not uncommon.



A foremost attraction is The Hide's waterhole. There are two "hides", concealed viewing areas, right at the edge of the waterhole. This offers a totally secure haven for remarkable close encounters and incredible photographs of some of Hwange's elephants and an array of other wildlife. One of the hides is accessible via an underground tunnel, just steps from the main lodge deck. This tunnel is open throughout the day and evening, and slipping down to see the animals up close is truly a special experience.



The Hide is featured in the recent book "1000 Places To See Before You Die - A Traveler's Life List". For a romantic dinner after a long day of game driving, The Hide's underground wine cellar makes for a perfect spot for a private, quiet dinner for two. Or perhaps you are a bit more adventurous and would like to spend the night in the private "tree house", the Dove's Nest. *NOTE: Private dinners in the wine cellar & sleep outs at the Dove's Nest are based on availability and must be booked in advance.*



Accommodation: 1 x classic tent on all-inclusive basis for 3 nights (Single supplements will apply)



Wednesday, August 03, 2016 - Johannesburg

Today you will be transferred from The Hide to Hwange Main Camp.

From Hwange Main Camp you will be transferred by road to **Victoria Falls Airport**, where you will connect with your international flight to **Johannesburg, South Africa**. (This flight needs to be booked and is not included in the itinerary price.)



Flight to book on South African Air:

1:15pm depart Victoria Falls (VFA), SA 41

2:55pm arrive Johannesburg (JNB), SA 41

On arrival at the Johannesburg Airport, you will need to transfer and check in for your onward, international flights home. (These flights need to be booked and are not included in the itinerary costs.)
